4 Think Before You Share Never post your address, phone number, school name, or birthday. 	5 Be Careful on Public Wi-Fi Never log into your accounts or enter personal information. 6 Look into Apps Before you Download Only download from official app stores and check what information it can access. 	7 Tell a Trusted Adult If someone asks for photos or personal info, or makes you uncomfortable – STOP and TELL.
